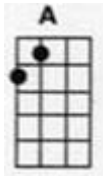


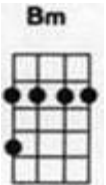
# Flowers on the Wall

*The Statler Brothers*

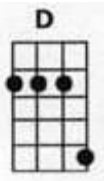
**Intro:** [D][Bm][E7][A]

Countin' [Bm<sup>1</sup>] flowers on the wall, that don't [Bm<sup>1</sup>] bother me at all  
Playin' [Bm<sup>1</sup>] solitaire 'til dawn, with a [Bm<sup>1</sup>] deck of fifty-one  
Smokin' [G] cigarettes and watchin' "Captain Kangaroo"  
Now don't tell [A] me, I've [G] nothin' to [A] do



Last [D] night I dressed in tails pretended [Bm] I was on the town  
As [E7] long as I can dream it's hard to [A] slow this swinger down
